The small schools athletics carnival has been booked in for Tuesday 14th May with a back up date of Thursday 16th May. This will be held at the Coolamon Central School oval.


With the weather turning and children requiring jumpers, etc, it would be appreciated if their clothing could be checked, to ensure that they are clearly labelled with their name.



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

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
